



# **FFCC Revenue v. Cost Projection**



What Does This Mean?

**Defining Success:** Based on historical data from last season, attendees are ready to be engaged at any of our 8 speaker luncheons and are generous in their support through memberships and donations. With that said, we predict an average overall attendance this season to be at 1600.

**Revenue:** With a projected attendance of 1600 for the 2023-24 season, overall luncheon revenue will rely on tickets sales (73%) and annual Memberships which are projected at 27% of the total.

**Expenses:** Luncheon Costs which include the ULC charge plus administrative expenses typically escalate every year with this season being no exception. Fortunately, First Friday has also seen an escalation in donations and memberships, allowing First Friday to project a positive cash flow for the 2023-24 season.

**Mind the Gap:** The ticket price for a luncheon does not cover First Friday's total cost per event. To cover this *gap*, we need your continued support through memberships and donations in order keep moving forward!
